


52 Verses on Facing Fear

1. “Peace I leave with you; My peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.” John 14:27 NIV
2. “Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.” 1 Peter 5:7 NIV
3. “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.” Philippians 4:6-8 NIV
4. “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.” 2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV
5. “You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in You, all whose thoughts are fixed on You!” Isaiah 26:3 NLT
6. “When I am afraid, I will trust in you.” Psalm 56:3 NIV
7. “The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and He delivers them.” Psalm 34:7 NIV
8. “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you.” Deuteronomy 31:6 NIV
9. “The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?” Psalm 27:1 NIV
10. “The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.” Romans 16:20 NIV
11. “Perfect love casts out fear...” 1 John 4:18 ESV
12. “I sought the Lord and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears.” Psalm 34:4 NIV
13. “The Lord your God, who is going before you, will fight for you ...” Deuteronomy 2:30 NIV
14. “Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are Mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.” Isaiah 43:1-3 NIV

16. "I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33 NIV

17. "All the days of the desponding and afflicted are made evil by anxious thoughts and forebodings, but he who has a glad heart has a continual feast regardless of circumstances." Proverbs 15:15 AMP

18. "I sought the LORD, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears. Those who look to Him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame." Psalm 34:4-5 NIV

19. "But my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19 ESV

20. "As for me, I look to the LORD for help. I wait confidently for God to save me, and my God will certainly hear me." Micah 7:7 NLT

21. "For [the Spirit which] you have now received [is] not a spirit of slavery to put you once more in bondage to fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption [the Spirit producing sonship] in [the bliss of] which we cry, Abba (Father)! Father!" Romans 8:15 AMP

22. "The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and He helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise Him." Psalm 28:7 NIV

23. "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear..." Psalm 46:1-2 NIV


24. "O LORD, if You heal me, I will be truly healed; if You save me, I will be truly saved. My praises are for You alone!" Jeremiah 17:14 NLT


25. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9 NIV

26. "With this news, strengthen those who have tired hands, and encourage those who have weak knees. Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, and do not fear, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you." Isaiah 35:3-4 NLT

27. "This I declare about the LORD: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; He is my God, and I trust Him." Psalm 91:2 NLT

28. "He will cover you with His feathers. He will shelter you with His wings. His faithful promises are your armor and protection." Psalm 91:4 NLT

29. “Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love Him.” James 1:12 NIV
30. “The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.” Lamentations 3:22-23 ESV
31. “The Lord your God is in the midst of you, a Mighty One, a Savior [Who saves]! He will rejoice over you with joy; He will rest [in silent satisfaction] *and* in His love He will be silent *and* make no mention [of past sins, or even recall them]; He will exult over you with singing.” Zephaniah 3:17 AMP
32. “There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.” Romans 8:1 ESV
33. “Can anything ever separate us from Christ’s love? Does it mean He no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?... No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.” Romans 8:35,37 NLT
34. “I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 8:38-39 NLT
35. “Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.” 2 Corinthians 4:17-18 NIV
36. “They who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.” Isaiah 40:31 ESV
37. “Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; He will neither fail you nor abandon you.” Deuteronomy 31:8 NLT
38. “In my distress I prayed to the LORD, and the LORD answered me and set me free.” Psalm 118:5 NLT
39. “I am counting on the LORD; yes, I am counting on Him. I have put my hope in His word.” Psalm 130:5 NLT
40. “You are my refuge and my shield; Your word is my source of hope.” Psalm 119:114 NLT

46. “The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.” Psalm 23 ESV
47. “For He [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you *nor* give you up *nor* leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless *nor* forsake *nor* let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!]” Hebrews 13:5 AMP
48. “Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because He has come to His people and redeemed them. He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of His servant David.... to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve Him without fear in holiness and righteousness before Him all our days.” Luke 1:68-69, 70-74 NIV
49. “Let us then fearlessly *and* confidently *and* boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God’s unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].” Hebrews 4:16 AMP
50. “Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.” 1 Corinthians 16:13 NIV
51. “Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great *and* glorious compensation of reward.” Hebrews 10:35 AMP
52. “Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you His peace at all times and in every situation. The Lord be with you all.” 2 Thessalonians 3:16 NLT
